

# Rochester Brooks 2018 Hunting Policy

- **Only** current **REGULAR members** are allowed to use the property for the purpose hunting. Non-Resident and Student members do not have the privilege to hunt the property.
- Members may **NOT** bring guests.
- All members **MUST** have Rochester Brooks ID badges visible while hunting.
- Tree stands and blinds cannot be installed prior to 9/1/18 and they **MUST** be removed by 12/31/2018. Club management reserves the right to remove any stands or blinds after this date. **NO** building permanent stands! **Tree stands and blinds MUST have VISIBLE identification with the owners name attached.**
- Members who wish to hunt the property must register themselves and their vehicle at the club office prior to the start of the season. Parking on club property and hunting adjoining properties is **NOT** allowed. This includes the adjoining state land as well. Club management reserves the right to tow any non-registered vehicle.
- Hunting will **NOT** be allowed while the club is operational. This applies to the hours before and after the club is open. In short, **NO** hunting Saturday, Sunday, or Wednesday.
- **ALL ranges** as well as the club house will be closed on Saturday, November 17th, 2018 for the opening day of shotgun season. This is the **ONLY** Saturday hunting will be allowed. **ONLY hunters that have registered with the club will be granted access that day and for the remaining season.**
- Regular hours of operation will resume Sunday November 18th and **NO** hunting will be allowed that day. In addition, there will be **NO hunting on Friday November 23<sup>rd</sup> 2018. All ranges and club will be open that day.**
- **ALL hunters MUST follow ALL NYS laws and regulations!**
- Any violation of these rules **will result in an automatic suspension** of membership and hunting privileges and the member will need to request Board approval for reinstatement.
- During **Gun Season**, hunters on RBGC Property are **required** to wear **at least 25%** of their body in **Hunter Orange** to be visible to other hunters.
- Hunters need to be courteous to all RBGC Staff. We still have to be able to safely work on the Sporting Clay courses. We will try to keep disruptions to a minimum.
- Firearm safety is of the utmost importance! Always be aware of other hunters and your surroundings. ***Be safe and good luck!***
