

SHOOT OFF INFORMATION

Final “best of 7” scores are attached. If anyone spots any errors or omissions please let me know as soon as possible, as these are the scores which will be used to assign the shoot off classes.

The Trophy Teams shoot off on Sunday, and the squad times are provided.

Trophy teams are listed high score to low, in alphabetical order for those who are tied. You will determine your shooting order when you sign up at Dansville.

If you have been selected to a Trophy Team, please be advised that if there is a tie for either Champion or Runner-Up, there will be a 5-man team shoot off called at approximately 2:45 pm Sunday afternoon, to determine who gets the trophy that will be handed out at the banquet in April 27.

Some ties have been broken, either for a trophy team member, or for the person designated as alternate. By league rules, the tie-breaker for placement on trophy teams is as follows:

| If still tied | Total number of 50x50 shot |
| If still tied | Total number of 25x25 shot |
| If still tied | Long run, front or back |

As usual, the “best of 450 targets” settled all the ties – proving once again it’s a good idea to support every club, every shoot.

League members who are not assigned to a Trophy Team may shoot either Saturday or Sunday, just like every other league weekend. All league members are encouraged to come to this final shoot, it’s where the prize money is won. An equal prize amount goes to each class, and with 6 classes, shooters compete only against other shooters of similar ability. Lots of fun! Class awards, too, not just money.

For those of you who are directors representing your club, you have the following responsibilities:

- a. Confirm that your Trophy Team members plan to shoot, and notify your alternate(s) if a vacancy exists, to be sure you have 5 shooters ready to go when your squad is called Sunday.
- b. Provide a door prize for the league banquet, valued at \$25 or more, on behalf of your club. You may bring this door prize to the shoot off, or to the league banquet, whichever is more convenient.
- c. If your club won a traveling trophy last season (1st or 2nd in league, 1st or 2nd in shoot-off) **please bring this to the shoot off for engraving** for the banquet.
